

Cookie & Privacy Policy

The Protectme.net website is run by Pyramid Travel Products and is committed to protecting and respecting your privacy. This policy sets out the basis on which any personal data we collect from you, or that you provide to us, will be processed by us.

For the purpose of the Data Protection Act 1998 (the Act), the data controller is Scotmas Ltd of Spylaw Road, Kelso, TD5 8DL.

1. INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

- i. information that you provide by filling in forms on our site www.pyramidtravelproducts.co.uk (our Site). This includes information provided when you subscribe to a service, register to receive brochures, or participate in contests, sweepstakes and/or promotions. This information may include your name, shipping address, telephone number, email address;
- ii. details of your visits to our Site including, but not limited to, traffic data, location data, and other communication data, and the resources that you access;

We may also ask you for information when you report a problem with our Site. If you contact us, we may keep a record of that correspondence.

2. COOKIES

- i. We may collect information about your computer, including your IP address, operating system and browser type, for system administration and to report aggregate information to our advertisers. This is statistical data about our users' browsing actions and patterns, and does not identify any individual.
- ii. For the same reason, we may obtain information about your general internet usage by using a cookie file which is stored on the hard drive of your computer. Cookies contain information that is transferred to your computer's hard drive. We use Google Analytics cookies to help improve our Site and to deliver a better and more personalised service.
- iii. You may refuse to accept cookies by altering the setting on your browser which allows you to refuse the setting of cookies. However, if you select this setting you may be unable to access certain parts of our Site. Unless you have adjusted your browser setting so that it will refuse cookies, our system will issue cookies when you visit our Site.
- iv. Cookies can be removed or blocked by following the directions for your web browser

3. WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA

The data that we collect from you may be transferred to, and stored at, a destination outside the European Economic Area ("EEA"). It may also be processed by staff operating outside the EEA who work for us or for one of our suppliers. Such staff may be engaged in, among other things, the provision of support services. By submitting your personal data, you agree to this transfer, storing or processing. We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.

Unfortunately, the transmission of information via the internet is not completely secure. Although we will do our best to protect your personal data, we cannot guarantee the security of your data transmitted to our Site; any transmission is at your own risk. Once we have received your information, we will use strict procedures and security features to try to prevent unauthorised access.

4. USES MADE OF THE INFORMATION

We may use information held about you in the following ways:

- i. to ensure that content from our Site is presented in the most effective manner for you and for your computer;
- ii. to provide you with information, products or services that you request from us;
- iii. to notify you about changes to our service;
- iv. to carry out our obligations arising from any contracts entered into between you and us.

Provided you have given your consent, we may also use your data, or permit selected third parties to use your data, to provide you with information about goods and services which may be of interest to you and we or they may contact you about these by email, post or telephone.

5. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

We may disclose your personal information to any member of our group, which means our subsidiaries, our ultimate holding company and its subsidiaries, as defined in section 1159 of the UK Companies Act 2006.

We do not store credit card details nor do we share customer details with any 3rd parties.

6. YOUR RIGHTS

You have the right to ask us not to process your personal data for marketing purposes. We will usually inform you (before collecting your data) if we intend to use your data for such purposes or if we intend to disclose your information to any third party for such purposes. You can exercise your right to prevent such processing by checking or not checking (as the case may be) certain boxes on the forms we use to collect your data. 7. ACCESS TO INFORMATION

The Act gives you the right to access information held about you. Your right of access can be exercised in accordance with the Act. Any access request may be subject to a fee of £10 to meet our costs in providing you with details of the information we hold about you.
